The Ashtabula City Health Department has received inquiries regarding the possibility of dangers from the train derailment in East Palestine, Ohio to Ashtabula City Residents. The air and ground water quality surrounding the event in East Palestine continues to be monitored on a daily basis by the EPA. Based on current daily results, there is no immediate danger to the residents in Ashtabula County/Ashtabula City. If the levels change and indicate that there is a concern, the public will be notified.
